PRESENTATION ON SOCIAL MEDIA MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Kaye Henrickson shared her findings on how CESA #4 districts are using social media.

- Very few districts using Instagram
- Twitter principals, superintendents and some teachers use twitter as individual accounts not as much districts accounts
- 17 of the 26 districts have a fully functional Facebook presence (of those 17 1 in 3 have consistent or systemic posts)
- 42% of CESA #4 districts have social media accessible on website

STEM – Inquiry learning – have students problem solve- CESA has various items to loan out to districts

- Make and take kits that focus on a book at the elementary or middle school level that show teachers how inexpensive items can be used to make items around the content of the book
- Spheros (programmable ball that students can maneuver with apps and learn beginning programming code)
 Spark education has ready-made lesson plans/standards aligned for teachers to use
- LEGO mindstorm kits (have trained over 70 educators on how to utilize the kits in their classrooms).

Cheryl acknowledged Kaye Henrickson who was recently awarded the International Society in Education (ISTE) "Making It Happen" award given in partnership with the Wisconsin Educational Multimedia and Technology Association (WEMTA). Kaye will be honored at the WEMTA Conference in early April.
